

REGISTRATION OF HORSES

ONLY purebred arabian horses – horses registered in an official WAHO-recognized StudBook. For horses under one year old, registration can be done based on the foaling application.

The show is registered by the EAHSC (European Arab Horse Show Commission) and is conducted according to the EAHSC Show Rules.

Horses placed 1-3 in this Show are eligible to participate in All National Cup, European and World Championships.

ENTRY RESTRICTION: Title Show or A Show Champion Gold and Silver medal winners are not allowed to take part in a C International show for the rest of that calendar year and the two calendar years following, unless the horse has passed from a yearling to junior, from junior to a senior category. • Gold medal winners in two B international or two C International or one B International and one C International Shows in the same year are not allowed to take part in a C International Show for the rest of that calendar year. • Geldings that have won Champion Gold or Silver medals at a Title Show or an A show cannot be shown at C shows for the rest of that calendar year and one calendar year following. • Anybody entering an overqualified horse will be liable to a fine of €600 and the horse will be disqualified.

CLASSES:

1. Yearling Fillies (born in 2022)
2. Yearling colts (born in 2022)
3. 2 years old fillies (born in 2021)
4. 2years old colts (born in 2021)
5. 3 years old fillies (born in 2020)
6. 3 years old colts (born in 2020)
7. Mares 4-6 years old (born between 2017-2019)
8. Stallions 4-6 years old (born between 2017-2019)
9. Mares 7-10 years old (born between 2013-2016)
10. Stallions 7-10 years old (born between 2013-2016)
11. Mares 11 years or older (born in 2012, or before)
12. Stallions 11 years and older (born in 2012, or before)
- 13 Geldings 1-3 years (born between 2020-2022)
- 14 Geldings over 4 years (born in 2019 and before)

JUDGING CRITERIA FOR PURE ARABIAN HORSES

The judging of the pure-bred arabian horses is done according to the judging criteria and after the official ECAHO regulations, as follows:

Each judge will evaluate the participants of each class without a catalog, independently and according to 5 criteria:

1. Type
2. Head and neck
3. Body
4. Legs
5. Movement

The judging system is the 20-point system, using half points as well. His/her score is collected from each judge. The final score is obtained by adding the scores of the different judges and divide by the number of judges operating.

In case of a tie of total of points of two or more horses in a class, the score obtained for the “type” will define the ranking. If there is a tie in this case as well, the highest score obtained for "movement" will be taken into account.

All horses that have achieved one of the first two places in their class are eligible to participate in the Championship. The judges will judge independently of each other. The judges and the public will first look at the finalists in motion one by one, then they will be distributed in the judging rectangle, where the judges will mark on their judging sheets the gold, silver, bronze and, as a reserve, the 4th place finisher, which will be added up by the judges and the result announced. In the Championship, the following titles can be achieved:

Junior- gold, silver, bronze Champion filly

1-3-5-13. classes

Junior- gold, silver, bronze Champion colt

2-4-6-13. classes

Senior- gold, silver, bronze Champion Mare

7-9-11-14. classes

Senior- gold, silver, bronze Champion Stallion

8-10-12-14. classes

Championships will be conducted according to the EAHSC rules ([www. ECAHO.org](http://www.ECAHO.org)).



AWARDING TITLES

The title of winner is awarded by the judges for each of the above classes. From the winners (regardless of age and gender) choose: WINNER of the Show (Best of show)

Awards:

The winners of the classes receive medals and cups, prizes in objects or money from the sponsors.

OTHER REGULATIONS

1. The handler of the horse is decently dressed, black trousers with black shoes, white blouse or shirt are recommended. It is recommended to use a training whip with or without plastic wrap without being used to hit the animal. The handler will wear a starting number.
2. The handler may not wear advertising inscriptions referring to the owner of the horse.
3. Agressive horses can be eliminated, by the majority vote of the arbitration committee.
4. Only one handler with each horse enters the judging arena.
5. The judges may ask the ringmaster to ask the horse's handler to lift a hoof or open the horse's mouth.
6. The judges evaluate the horses in a static position, in walk and in trot.
7. Mares and young stallions can be led with a display harness (with a chain under the chin). Stallions older than 3 years of age have to be presented with a bit. All harnesses must be strong and secure.
8. Horses that get out of hand are judge in the end of the class. On the second escape the horse is eliminated.

Lameness

9. Horses with lameness can be presented only if walking does not cause pain to the horse.

Forbiddens

10. Changing (dyeing) the original color of short hair, mane and tail as well as hooves. The hooves cannot be painted. Cosmetic surgery is not accepted. A colorless ointment or white chalk on white hair is accepted.
11. It is forbidden to cut the eyelashes or the hair inside the ear as well as the palpating mustache. The horses shown can be partially shaved (the mane is cut 20-25 cm behind the ears).

Hereditary disorders

12. Overbite/underbite Overbite/underbite of more than 1 width of tooth is not permitted. Horses 12 months old and older cannot compete unless they have a veterinary certificate to verify that they do not have overbite/underbite.
- 13 Cryptorchidism Colts 24 months old and older or stallions cannot compete unless they have a veterinary certificate to verify that they do not have cryptorchidism. If the colt's condition changes, and upon a completed veterinary certificate, the horse is then eligible to compete.

The Blue Book 2023 is applicable.

The organizing committee cannot be held responsible for any damage or injury caused by the horses presented!

All participants will complete and sign a statement on their own responsibility.

AWARD CEREMONY

The schedule of the competition program may change depending on the number of participants in the classes, unfavorable weather conditions, unpredictable aspects.

Receiving horses at the base: **7 September 2023.**

The release of the boxes is made no later than **10 September 2023.**

Horses will not be accepted in the club yard unless they are properly vaccinated and have not passed the tests (infectious anemia) up to date on the passport. Passports and transport certificates are handed over to the secretariat on the day of arrival.

Horse accommodation conditions: boxes and paddocks.

ENTRY FEE PER HORSE/PER CLASS: 350 lei (or 70 euro)

The box fee is 350 lei or 70 euro (07-10.09.2023) , including straw but the hay must be bought separately.
